Today was one of those days that if you missed sailing at Clear Lake, you truly missed a great day of sailing.

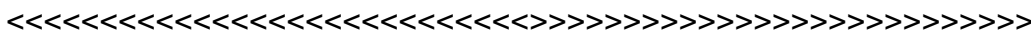
