Saturday evening dinner buffet at Sunset Fishing Resort, National meeting to follow
Sunday June 20th, race 6 start 11 am, race 7 to follow

equipment: Sailors must race an El Toro, measured and recognized by the El Toro Class

Only two(2) main sails may be used during the regatta

Sails and boats may be re-measured at any time during the Series

venue and race area: Clear Lake, California, USA

scoring: Low point scoring system currently in effect

support boats: Coach boats will not be allowed in race area

sailing instructions: "SI" will be available at the Skippers Meeting noon on Friday, June 18th
