- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category A.
 - 3. Eligibility and Entry
- 3.1 The regatta is open to all members of the El Toro Class, DaySailor Class, Lido 14 Class and Windmill Class. Membership and adherence to class

rules will be the responsibility of the classes.

4. Entry Fee \$35 for the weekend of races, payable at check in.

5. Schedule:

5.1 Regatta registration and check in will commence at 10:00 Saturday, 15 June, 2013 at the Clear Lake Cottages and Marina, 13885 Lakeshore Dr., Clear

Lake, CA 95422.

- 5.2 Registration and check in will close at 11:30, June 15, 2013.
- 5.3 A skipper's meeting will be held at 11:30, noon, 15 June, at the Clear Lake Cottages and Marina. Participants should launch their boats and be ready to race prior to this meeting.
- 5.4 Racing will start at 12:00 noon Saturday, Weather permitting, four or five races will be sailed on Saturday and two on Sunday. The first race on Saturday will commence immediately after the skipper's meeting. The first race on Sunday will commence at 10:30. One completed race will constitute a regatta.
 - 6. Sailing Instructions will be distributed at check in. Two windward marks will be used. There may be a leeward gate used.
 - 7. Venue
 - 7.1 Races will be conducted in the vicinity of the Clear Lake Cottages and Marina on Lower Lake, Clear Lake.
 - 8. Races Courses.
 - 8.1 Courses will be published in the Sailing Instructions.
 - 9. Scoring
 - 9.1 The Low Point System, Appendix A4, will be used to score races.
 - 9.2 A boat's worst race score will be thrown out if all six scheduled races are sailed.
