Here is the pricing for my wood El Toro hulls. I have it in 3 stages so the do-it-yourselfer can save money.

Stage 1:

Bare Hull (just out of the mold) It comes with the air tanks installed. It includes the parts to complete the hull. Included are: Dagger board trunk and thwart parts. Deck framing, mast step parts, deck, keel strip and rub rails. \$900

Stage 2:

All of above, but with the dagger board trunk and thwart installed. Also included is 4 oz. fiberglass cloth to cover the bottom and sides. \$1100

Stage 3:

A complete hull with all parts installed. Bottom or bottom & sides are glassed, the rest is sealed with epoxy. All finishing and painting to be done by the customer. \$1500

Foil blanks:

Flat, edge glued sitka spruce or with spruce / mahogany combination. 5/8" thick. Ready for the customer to hand fair & finish.

Dagger board \$40

Rudder \$40 (includes tiller handle)

Wood Spars
